

Award Description

This award is open to all government, public and private health service delivery organizations who operate in a low-income country (according to the [World Bank](#)) and/or operate in a region, territory or country during times of significant crisis (war or natural disaster). The award will recognize demonstration of excellence or outstanding achievements in delivering health services despite the challenges of their environment.

To qualify for the award:

- The health service organization is located in low-income country according to World Bank and/or in a region, territory or country facing a major crisis (war or natural disaster);
- The organization had experienced or is currently experiencing a crisis that places a significant strain on its operations;
- The organization developed and implemented a service, program, or project which allowed it to demonstrate excellence or outstanding achievements despite the harsh conditions;
- A significant part of the organization's service, program or project should be attributed to its "people" and their initiatives to deliver health care despite of the crisis.

Service, Program or Project Information

3. Outline the specific goals or targets envisaged prior to initiation of the project, programme, or service. (300 words maximum)
4. Describe the steps or stages involved in executing the project, programme, or service. Include in the description the involvement of management, staff, patients and other stakeholders. (300 words maximum)
5. How does this project, programme, or service demonstrate the organization's excellence or outstanding achievement in delivering health services despite the challenges of their environment? What are the significant and sustainable results, outcomes or improvements? (300 words maximum)
6. Describe how the new project, programme, or service was received by the organization's stakeholders. Has the project been recognized by the community or received an award nationally, regionally or internationally? Has the new project been adopted by other organizations and what is the likelihood for broader adoption? (300 words maximum)
